Starter	10 mins	Title posted on board or on table cards Mini whiteboards & pens Post it notes Paper and pens	Place the industry sector title out there – on the board/ on a card on the table Think moment and get young people to write on post it/mini whiteboard their thoughts in answer to: What does this title mean to you? 1 - 2 mins to think and write down – can be a word/drawing or sentence Pair moment – discuss with another person the answer they have – each take it in turns to explain Share moment within either small groups/whole class – RECORD the ideas Ask a student or 2 to Sum up what discovered This could be added to by asking: *What companies' people might have mentioned when doing the answers? *Does anyone have a member of the family that works in this sector? -What do they do? OR Use the title and in small groups get them to record on paper all they know about that title What it means to them? What they think people do in that area? What skills/qualities they think are important for someone who is involved in that area? Where can they work locally? In Somerset? Further afield?			

			Get each group to feedback to others about the different questions each person in the group taking part Get someone to record and sum up – similarities/variations in thinking.		
Main Activity	30 to 40 mins	Link to relevant TalentEd Academy or EBP site www.somerset- ebp.co.uk/talented This involves use of IT so space would need to be booked for class if the students do not have access to their own IT equipment. Mini whiteboards and pens	Students to use IT to watch the specific TalentEd Academy your curriculum area links to and complete the embedded quiz. If Teacher shows the TA to whole class, there cannot be a certificate for everyone at the end of the lesson. It is important to consider how to handle the embedded quiz which appears at the end of each section. This will require feedback from all about the answers by using mini white boards & pens or show of hands. At the end of the quiz, it is sensible to read the reflection at the end before continuing to the next part of the input.
