PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME Essential information

Course overview

Traineeships are ideal for individuals aged 16-24 who require support to gain an apprenticeship or job, and would benefit from work experience in a real working environment.

It is a programme of work skills and a work experience placement run over 12 -15 weeks.

During the traineeship, Huish will support trainees to maximise their CV's, teach them to write application forms that stand out and become more confident in an interview.

Traineeships are also good at supporting people that lack confidence and self-esteem. We will arrange a suitable work experience placement that will allow the Trainee to gain real experience in their chosen sector. Huish specialise in Traineeships for those who want to work in Business Admin, ICT, Customer Service, Health and Social Care and Accountancy but can support in other fields.

At the end of the traineeship, we will work with you to apply for an apprenticeship or other training or employment opportunities to progress on to. A former Trainee commented: "I went from rock bottom to the happiest in my life. I'm now doing an apprenticeship."

Who can apply	 Traineeships are aimed at 16 to 24-year-olds that meet the following requirements: Are not currently in a job and have little work experience Have qualifications below Level 3 Have been resident in the EU for the past 3 years Are keen, enthusiastic and reliable.
Progression	When you have completed the traineeship you should be ready to move onto a full time paid apprenticeship. Your mentor will help find the right one for you. We will work with you to search the National Apprenticeship database for suitable vacancies and support your applications.
